Registration

To join City of Edinburgh Basketball Club (CoEBC), all members (players, volunteers or coaches must register with:

- Basketball Scotland (BS)
- Then complete CoEBC registration form

STEP 1: Read the full Registration Pack first to ensure you select the correct Basketball Scotland Category based on the appropriate team.

STEP 2: Join Basketball Scotland

If you are new to Basketball Scotland click [Login - JustGo](#) and select 'Sign Up' button.

- Enter player's details, followed by parent/ guardian details
- Select 'City of Edinburgh' Club * Select 'Marketing Preferences' - then 'Accept & Continue'
- Depending on the Team you are playing (See subscription grid for further information) for you will need to select one of the following Categories
 - Category 1 [Players Coaches & Officials] – NL Seniors, U18, U16, U14
 - Category 2 [Local League & University] Senior Local League Only Players & Coaches
 - Category 3 [Volunteers & Recreational] – U12, U10, Mini Hoop, Walking Basketball (Players & Coaches), all volunteers eg Team Managers, Committee Members and anyone looking to volunteer.
- Select age group
- Complete details - update 'Emergency Contact' / Select 'Player' / Select 'National & Local Leagues' / Update 'Nationality' & 'Registration' locations/ complete personal details
- You might need to upload a photo
- Select 'Finish'
- Select 'Proceed To Cart'
- Pay the membership fee for your child's age group.

If you already have a Basket Scotland account

- Click on [Login - JustGo](#)
- This should take you to your profile, where you can follow the steps above
- There's a forgotten password button if needed.

STEP 3: Read the appropriate [Code of Conduct – City of Edinburgh Basketball Club](#) for your age group as you will have to confirm this in the registration form.

STEP 4:

Complete the full [CoEBC Registration Form](#) via this link.

Only once Basketball Scotland and CoEBC registrations have been completed, will the player be fully registered to start training.

ALL :

Once you have paid the basketballscotland membership fee, the Club will be informed and we will then process your membership of the Club. You will receive a welcome email and the relevant invoices that allow you to pay your fees to join the Club. **Please note that all outstanding debts must be settled before a new season's membership will be processed.**

Payments can be made in full at the start of the season or paid monthly by the payment date on the invoice, you can specify your preference in your registration form.

The standing order payment option is not open to Jnr WNBA members.

We remain committed to allowing everyone to participate in basketball regardless of their financial circumstances. Anyone who faces genuine financial hardship that would mean that they were not able to join the Club should apply by email to the committee (cityofedinburgh@gmail.com) to request a reduction in their fees. All requests will be dealt with in confidence and each case will be decided on a case by case basis.

Gift Aid

City of Edinburgh Basketball Club is a charity registered in Scotland (<http://www.oscr.org.uk/>) and is registered as a charity with HMRC. One of the benefits of this is that it allows us to claim Gift Aid back on the Charity Joining Fee and Charity Membership Fee.

If in agreement, when you register, please complete the Gift Aid section. If you forget to do this at the time of registration a separate form available here [Policies & Forms « City of Edinburgh Basketball CLUB](#) This should be completed by a tax payer, so for example if you are paying for your child's fees and one parent is a tax payer and the other is not then it should be completed by the parent who is a tax payer.

Club Subscriptions

Once the registration form is processed, members will receive an invoice for the **Annual Charity Joining Fee** which must be paid by all members before training start back. Then separate invoices for the monthly membership/subscription. Please note when we set out our fees at the start of the year it is based on assumptions for membership numbers (based on previous years' growth) and budgeted costs (based on previous years' costs). This is the reason that we split subs into two to allow the club to review our actual outgoings and adjust membership costs in December and amend at the start of January if required.
